



Aluminum Bat Warranty

One Year Warranty:

Nike warrants this bat to be free of defects in materials or workmanship, under normal use, for a period of **ONE YEAR** from the date of purchase. This warranty excludes damage resulting from use in batting cages, use in sub 60 degrees Fahrenheit temperatures, misuse, improper handling or repair, or alterations. If your bat is defective, call **Nike Bat Warranty Service at 1-800-344-6453** to receive a claim number. Write the claim number on the original dated receipt, tape it to the barrel of the bat and ship it with an insured, traceable delivery service to:

No hand deliveries are accepted. Include a brief note with your name, shipping address, phone number and description of the claimed product flaw. Defective bats and inquires should only be directed to the number and address above, not to the retailer from which they were purchased. If there is a covered defect, the bat will be replaced one time only with the same bat (if available) or a similar Nike product of at least equal value at Nike's option. This warranty is in lieu of all other express or implied warranties. In no even shall Nike be liable for direct, indirect, incidental or consequential damages arising from the use of the bat, and any recovery is limited to the purchase price. In the USA, some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages or duration of an implied warranty, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which may vary from state to state. No other person or company is authorized to change this warranty, and your dealer is solely responsible for any warranties.

Care Instructions:

The product you purchased is a high-performance, this walled aluminum-alloy bat. In cold weather balls become harder and can damage your bat. Do not use your bat in batting cages. Most batting cages use high compression plastic balls that are likely to damage bats. Finally, there are common sense steps you can take to reduce the likelihood that your bat will dent.

- Rotate the barrel regularly each time you hit in order to spread impact points around the barrel.
- An entire team's usage may lead to excessive wear and shorten the bat's life.
